# Sunday Services

**At St Peter's we see ourselves as one big family where everyone can find a place to belong.**

On Sundays we meet at 9.30am in Church for our traditional service, 11.15am in the Hall for our all-age family service, and 6.30pm in Church for our informal evening praise.
