



TERMS OF SALE FOR MAXIMISE CONFERENCE TICKETS

ATTENDANCE

To attend Maximise you must have a valid ticket and have paid your ticket balance in full (except in the case of a leader who is on the leadership team for the conference).

REFUNDS/CANCELLATION

Ticket cancellations must be made in writing to the [9:38 administrator](#). Full refunds will be offered for cancellations made up to four weeks before the conference. There will be a £25 administration fee to process the cancellation. Within four weeks of the conference, we are not able to offer ticket refunds but you can transfer your ticket to another person.

FORCE MAJEURE CANCELLATION/POSTPONEMENT/REFORMATTING OF MAXIMISE

In the event that government restrictions or venue restrictions, due to Covid-19 or any other reason, mean that it is impossible to hold the Maximise Conference as a physical event on the dates scheduled, ticket purchasers will be offered a full refund. It may also be possible to offer the additional option of transferring the ticket to a postponed date. 9:38 cannot accept responsibility for any travel or other costs incurred.
