PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Support the Pastor in the day-to-day practical running of the church, as well as any operational matters.
- 2. Develop and maintain policies and procedures, updating and compiling risk assessments and policies when necessary.
- 3. Oversee systems for regular Sunday services: creating rotas, producing service sheets and organising the serving teams.
- 4. Organise and plan events in our annual church calendar, including some publicity work.
- 5. Coordinate building management, including chairing meetings of the building committee, arranging surveys and putting together building proposals.
- 6. Act as a point of contact for the church, particularly for the nursery who rent the hall space.
- 7. Arrange small finance matters.
- 8. Order and organise supplies.
