Holy Trinity Frogmore seeks to appoint enthusiastic team members who will assist with our ministry among all ages in our lively church. This post will include training at Cornhill or the

We are looking for one or two excellent candidates for our Ministry Trainee posts at Holy Trinity Frogmore.

CONDITIONS

Ministry Trainees are volunteers.

We will provide housing, a living allowance of £6000 per annum, all working expenses including travel and training course fees.

You will be part of a staff team led by the vicar, with a training curate, a self-supporting associate minister, a part-time Youth & Children's worker & part-time administrators.

The Parish of Frogmore is committed to the safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults, and the trainee will be subject to appropriate checks, at our expense.

The Vicar will be responsible for the supervision of the trainees, in consultation with the Wardens and relevant staff members. Trainees are accountable to the Parochial Church Council.

- We want to help people explore and train for full time ministry including ordination and youth work.
- We are looking for people with an aptitude for teaching, a servant attitude and a sense that full-time word ministry might be a possibility for the future. Our desire is to help you along that pathway; though embracing a secular career and local church lay leadership can be a good outcome too.
- The post will include a range of gospel ministry opportunities among all ages including speaking and leading as appropriate.
- We will support training one day per week (the Cornhill Training Course in London or the Four Counties Training course in Bedford).
- The post is for one or two years starting September 2020, including a three month probationary period.

HOLY TRINITY FROGMORE

We are a lively Anglican evangelical church of all ages in a village suburb of St Albans. Our vision is to be a family of disciples of all ages who love the Lord, love the Bible, love each other and love to make more disciples. In our approach to ministry we prioritise four P's:

Proclamation of God's word, the bible, through public preaching, personal bible study and conversations as the word is shared with all.

Prayer: depending on the Holy Spirit to empower this work.

People: God's family of disciples who love others, both inside and outside the church.

Perseverance: as God's work bears fruit in his timing and involves long-term commitment

As we **SOW** the word in people's lives, we pray that people come to **KNOW** Jesus for themselves, **GROW** as a disciple and join us as we **GO** in service of Jesus locally, nationally and globally.



OUR CHURCH LIFE

We serve our local area of Park Street, How Wood and Frogmore and the wider St Albans area. Our community is diverse, with central London commuters and social housing side by side. We are located 2 minutes from the M25 and near to a fast train link to central London. Many of our congregation live in the village and others from parts of St Albans and south-west Herts.

We have **two Sunday services:** a more traditional 9.00am service; and a contemporary family-friendly 10.30am service.

On a typical Sunday, there will be **80+ adults and 30+ children** in church.

Core church ministries include: 'Growth Groups', men's & women's bible studies, regular Christianity Explored courses, over 60's lunch club, a weekly parent & toddler group, pastoral care team as well as a lively youth and children's ministry including groups on Sunday morning and midweek and a large summer holiday club. We have close links with our church school where we take assemblies.

MINISTRY AT FROGMORE

The following will be tailored to a trainee's gifts and aspiration. We hope a trainee will have a willingness to be flexible and serve wholeheartedly in all sorts of tasks, in order to learn the most about ministry.

Training & Support

- Participation in a biblically-based training scheme (e.g. Cornhill London or Four Counties in Bedford) and we will fund this training.
- Regular supervisions with the Vicar or another senior staff team member.
- Membership of a church 'Growth Group'

Youth & Children's Work

- Leading and pastoral work for children and teenagers in the age range 0-18 years.
- Leading in our 'HotShots' Summer Holiday Club.
- Opportunities to take assemblies and classroom work at local Schools.
- Involvement with a Pathfinder or Venture camp (www.cpas.org.uk/ventures).

Adult Ministry

- Working with other men / women in the church to pastorally support and encourage them in service.
- Leading and giving Bible talks in a variety of contexts including Sunday Services.
- Small Group and One to One ministry.

And other practical service as the opportunity arises. In particular, IT & Internet skills would be very helpful.
